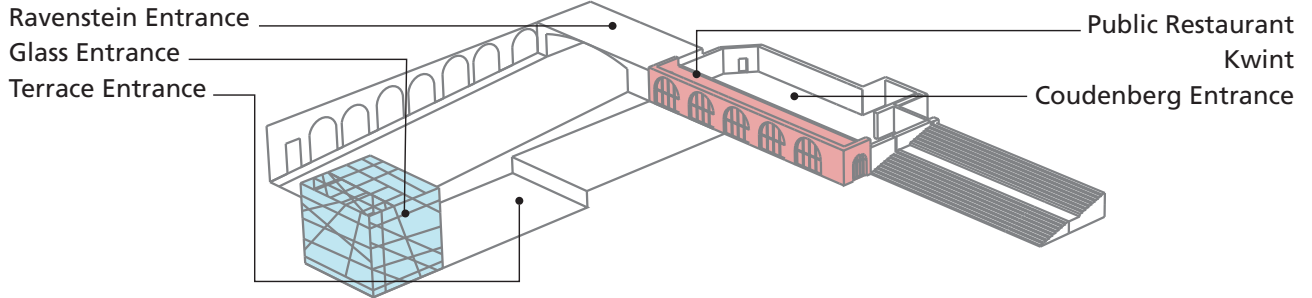

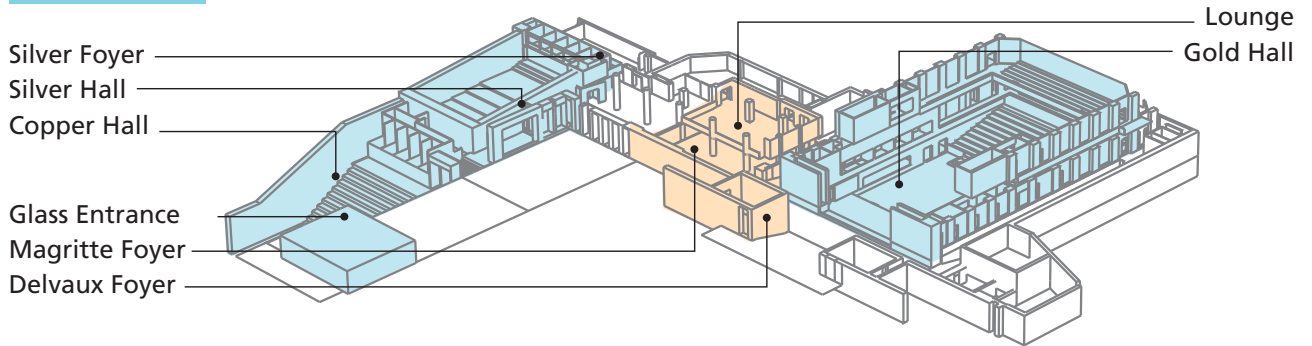


## GENERAL FLOOR PLAN

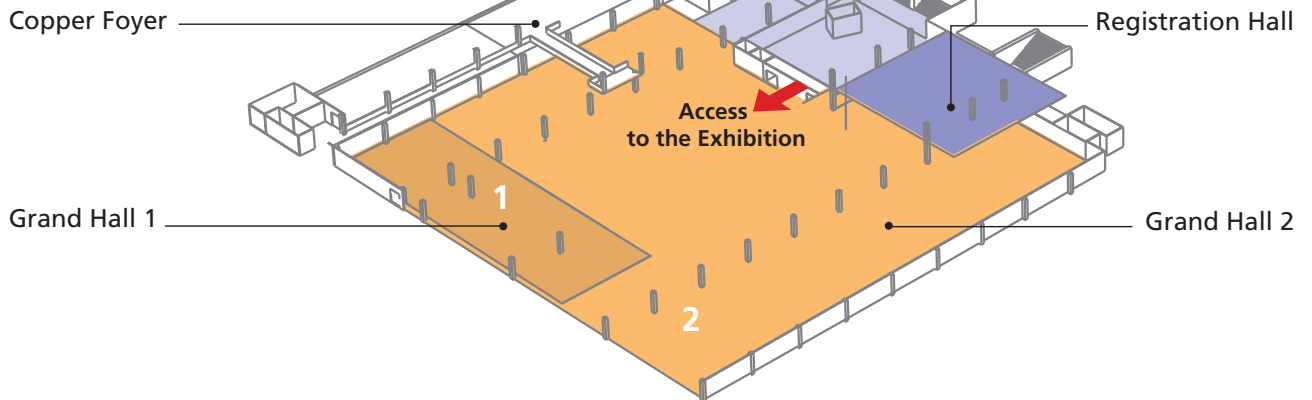

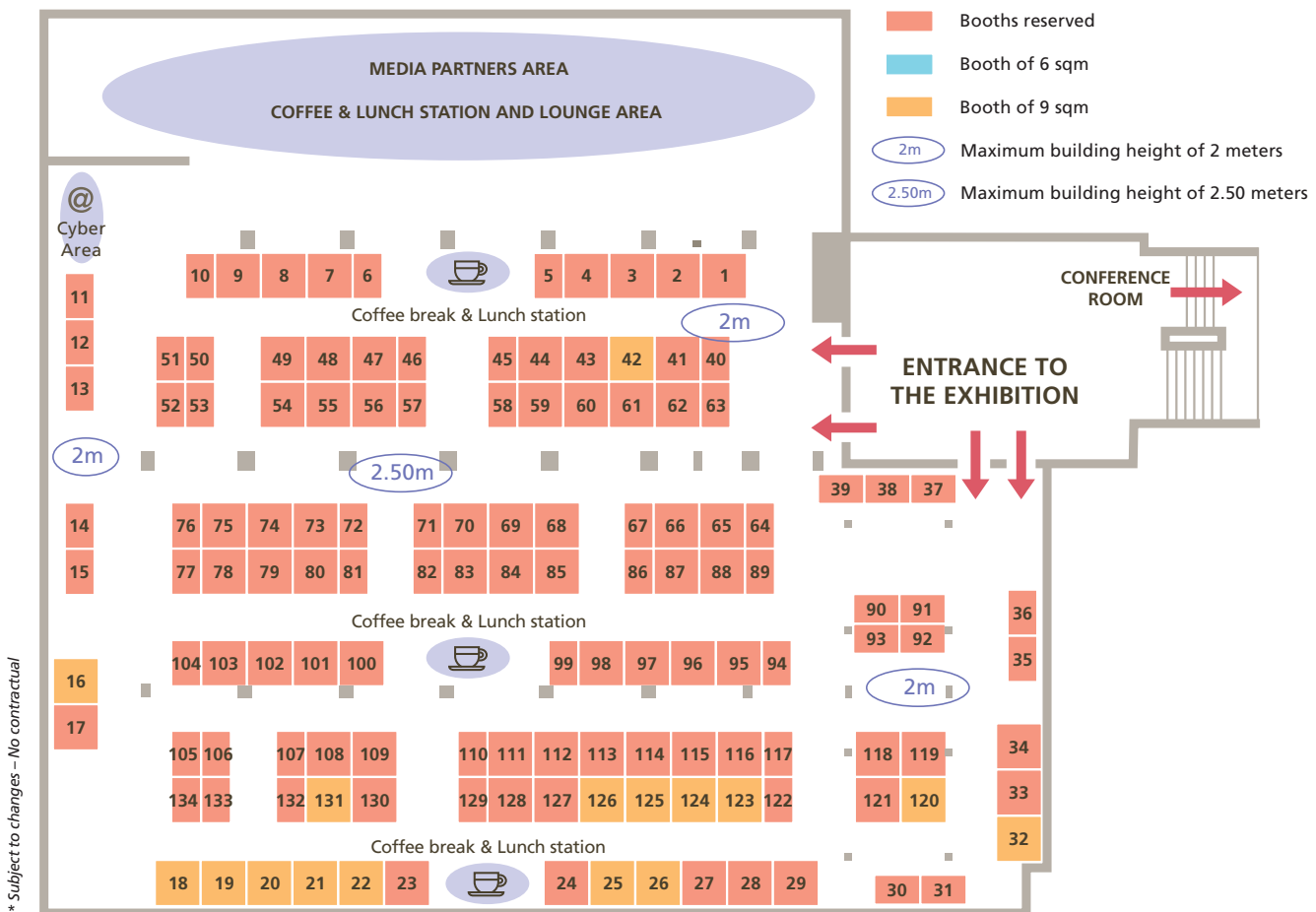
